LDB facility will start at Cochin from 16th November 2018 onwards and charges as prescribed by TAMP Notification No TAMP/46/2016-MUC and notified vide G. No. 248 Dated 03.07.2018 will be billed for all EXIM containers handled on the vessel that arrive from 00:01 Hrs of 16th November 2018 onwards. As per the direction of the aforesaid notification, the terminal will facilitate the collection of the MUC on behalf of DMICDC. The MUC will be charged in the same invoice along with Terminal Handling Charges.

TRADE NOTICE

Implementation of Logistics Data Bank Services by DMICDC for
'Track and Trace' of Containers at ICTT

The Ministry of Shipping vide letter dated 23.05.2018 directed all container handling Major Ports to provide Logistics Data Bank (LDB) Services on priority through the Delhi-Mumbai Industrial Corridor Development Corporation (DMICDC). The RFID based LDB Service will integrate the information available with various agencies across the supply chain to facilitate 'track and trace' of containers, an important parameter in the Logistics Performance Index of the World Bank.

The charges to be recovered from the users for providing the LDB Services to them have been prescribed by the TAMP, and notified vide G. No. 248 dated 03.07.2018. The LDB Facility is scheduled to be implemented at ICTT with effect from 16.11.2018, as under.

1. Rs.145/- + GST per container will be levied on all containers (except transshipment and coastal containers) handled at ICTT, the container terminal of Cochin Port Trust, towards Mandatory User Charge (MUC) for the LDB Service to be rendered by DMICDC.
2. The MUC of Rs.145/- per container prescribed is the ceiling rate. The Terminal Operator, IGTPPL, will have the liberty to charge lower rates in consultation with DMICDC.
3. The MUC shall come into effect from the date of commencement of LDB Service and shall remain valid till 31.03.2019.
4. Tracking and viewing the movement of containers across the ports to the ICDs and end users will be provided by the LDB through its portal www.ldb.co.in to the users against the payment of MUC.
5. 5% of the MUC shall be passed on to IGTPPL for collecting the MUC.
6. No Royalty/Revenue Share is payable by IGTPPL to Cochin Port Trust on the MUC collected.

The trade associations are requested to bring the aforesaid to the notice of all their members.
