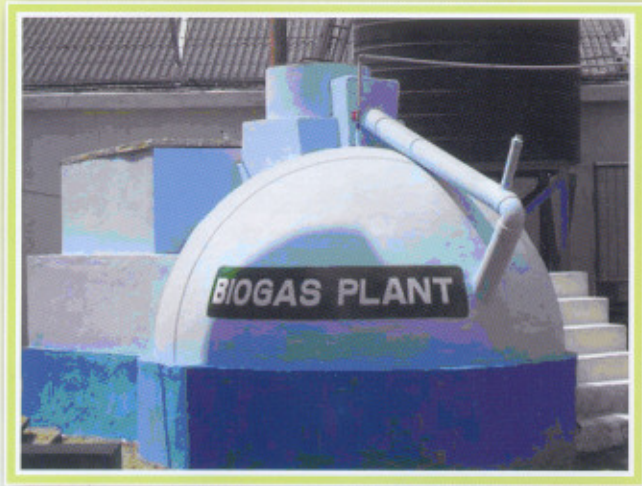


DP World Cochin sets up biogas plant



The biogas plant set up at DP World Cochin

The plant provides environmentally friendly disposal of kitchen waste and the generation of biogas.

The biogas is used to fire a special biogas stove which is better for the environment and saves on LPG, therefore cutting costs and the consumption of precious natural resources.

The plant also turns the kitchen waste into high quality manure, an excellent soil fertilizer which is used for the terminal's gardening purposes.
